## GSUSBC OPEN CITY TRIOS TOURNAMENT RULES

- All members of Greater Seattle USBC Association (GSUSBC) and all USBC members in good standing are eligible to bowl in this tournament. (See article 5 section a, USBC Constitution, Page 3 of USBC Rulebook.
- It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average, whether originally submitted by the bowler, the team captain, or others. Failure to use proper average or to make corrections prior to, or before completion of the first game of any event shall disqualify the score if submitted average is lower than actual average, or base prize winnings on submitted average if it is higher. (USBC rule 319a3)
- For handicap purposes, the highest book average of 21 games or more from the 2010-2011 winter season will be used. If a bowler does not have a 2010-2011 winter season average, the highest book average of 21 games or more from the 2010-2011 summer season will be used.
  - If no book average last year, use highest average of 21 games or more as of January 1, 2012. If no January 1, 2012 average, bowlers must bowl scratch (225). Bowlers not having a GSUSBC yearbook average must submit an average verification and/or current league standing sheet as of January 1, 2012.
  - USBC Rule 319d shall apply in this tournament for reporting prize-winning (\$600.00). Average adjustment requirements of USBC Rule 319e shall apply for average under 225. All bowlers who have had their average adjusted by other tournaments in the last 12 months must be reported before the first event bowled in the city tournament.
  - Sport league averages will be adjusted as per the sport league average adjustment chart.**
  - Tournament Director reserves right to re-rate average based upon information submitted.**
  - USBC Rule 319a2 (10 pin over) **DOES NOT** apply to this tournament.
- Handicap for trios will be 90% of 675.
- Multiple entries are allowed. Trios: You must change at least one bowler to cash more than once.
- Prize fees returned 100%. Prize ratio is at least 1 for every 6 entries. USBC Championship Chevrons will be awarded to the champions in each event.
- Entries will be accepted until the final scheduled squad for each event.
- Entries will be returned or adjusted in prizes with USBC approval if war, fire, labor strikes, an act of God, or any causes beyond control of the tournament makes it impossible or impractical to conduct or complete the tournament.
- A returned check is cause for disqualification of the entry. A \$35.00 fee will be charged for all returned checks.
- Entry fee: \$25.00 per person. Prize fee will be \$14.00, Lineage and expense fees \$11.00. Prize fee will be returned 100% in each event.
- Tournament director reserves the right to create additional squads, depending upon entries and the availability of lanes. Such squads will only be on the days listed on the entry form, with no squads created after Sunday, March 4, 2012, 1:00pm.
- All rules not covered shall be governed by the 2011/2012 USBC Rulebook(s).
- All Prize money winnings will be sent to the team captain and checks should be sent to you by that person.
