1. All members of Greater Seattle USBC Bowling Association (GSUSBC BA) are eligible to bowl in this tournament. (See article 5 section a, USBC Constitution, Page 3 of USBC Rulebook.
2. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average, whether originally submitted by the bowler, the team captain, or others. Failure to use proper average or to make corrections prior to, or before completion of the first game of any event shall disqualify the score if submitted average is lower than actual average, or base prize winnings on submitted average if it is higher. (USBC rule 319a3)
3. For handicap purposes, the highest book average of 21 games or more from the 2006-2007 season will be used.
  - a. If no book average last year, use highest average of 21 games or more as of January 1, 2008. If no January 1, 2008 average, the highest sanctioned summer league average of 21 games or more may be used. All others must bowl scratch (225). Bowlers not having a GSUSBCBA yearbook average must submit an average verification and/or current league standing sheet as of January 1, 2008.
  - b. USBC Rule 319d shall apply in this tournament for reporting prize-winning (\$600.00). Average adjustment requirements of USBC Rule 319e shall apply for average under 225. All bowlers who have had their average adjusted by other tournaments in the last 12 months must be reported before the first event bowled in the city tournament.
  - c. Sport league averages will be adjusted as per the sport league average adjustment chart.
  - d. Tournament Director reserves right to re-rate average based upon information submitted.
  - e. USBC Rule 319a2 does not apply to this tournament.
4. Handicap for Doubles will be 90% of 450, Handicap for Singles will be 90% of 225.
5. Multiple entries are allowed. Team Event: You must change at least 2 bowlers to cash more than once. Singles and Doubles: You may bowl the doubles event 5 times and Singles events 3 times: You must change partners to cash more than once in doubles. You may only cash once in Singles. Trios: You must change at least one bowler to cash more than once.
6. Doubles and Singles - Entry fee: \$25.00 per person/per event. Prize fee will be \$14.00, Lineage \$9.25 and expense fee will be \$1.75 - \$11.00.
7. Prize fees returned 100%. Prize ratio is at least 1 for every 6 entries. USBC Championship Chevrons will be awarded to the champions in each event.
8. Entries will be accepted until the final scheduled squad for each event.
9. The doubles event will be bowled immediately following the singles event. An entrant may not enter just the singles or doubles event on first entry. After the first entry you may enter both or one event.
10. Optional All Events: (Handicap and Scratch Divisions) must be paid before the first event bowled to be eligible. Prize ratio is at least 1-10 for All Events. Handicap All Events score will be based on first score with handicap bowled in the five-man, doubles, and singles events. Scratch All Events will be based on first scratch scores from five-man, trios, doubles and singles events.
11. All Events: entry fee will be \$15.00 scratch, \$10.00 handicap. All fees for All Events go to the prize fund, returned 100%.
12. Entries will be returned or adjusted in prizes with USBC approval if war, fire, labor strikes, an act of God, or any causes beyond control of the tournament makes it impossible or impractical to conduct or complete the tournament.
13. A returned check is cause for disqualification of the entry. A \$25.00 fee will be charged for all returned checks.
14. Tournament director reserves the right to create additional squads, depending upon entries and the availability of lanes. Such squads will only be on the days listed on the entry form, with no squads created after Sunday, 3/30/2008, 1:00 pm.
15. All rules not covered shall be governed by the 2007/2008 USBC Rulebook(s).
