RECOGNITIONS

GSWBA has many members that make contributions to the association. We would like volunteers to ask our bowlers to complete forms for deserving candidates:

HALL OF FAME: Looking for candidates in the area of meritorious service or superior performance. Review candidate resumes' and present to BOD for final selection. Candidates are inducted during the Annual Meeting.

MEMBER EMERITA: Looking for candidates who have given exemplary service to GSWBA. Review candidate resumes' and present to BOD for final selection. Following approval by the BOD, nominations shall then be submitted to the members for approval at a membership meeting.

SEATTLE VETERANS HOSPITAL FUND

Coordinate fund-raising efforts (sales table for Association meetings, city tournament, and other functions as deemed appropriate); attend annual Mail-O-Gram Tournament; frequent visits to the lanes during the veterans' Saturday bowling sessions.

Make recommendations for the operating budget to Board; Coordinate fund-raising efforts to supplement funds of the association; support specific projects.
